Vaccination Fee Schedule

Adults and children who are not VFC eligible are charged a fee for vaccinations, which includes the cost of the vaccine plus a \$10.00 administration fee. To be VFC eligible, a person must be 18 years or younger and meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Have Medicaid
- Have no health insurance
- Have health insurance that does not cover vaccinations
  - Be an American Indian or an American Eskimo

VFC eligible individuals are asked to give a \$10.00 per vaccine fee but not refused service because of the inability to do so.

We do bill Medicaid for covered vaccines and Medicare for Influenza and Pneumonia vaccines.  
We do not bill private insurance companies.

MMR (measles, mumps and rubella)	Pediatric or Adult	\$61.00 per dose
Tdap (Tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis)	Pediatric or Adult	\$46.00 per dose
Varicella (Chickenpox)	Pediatric or Adult	\$98.00 per dose
Zostavax (Shingles)	Age 60 & over	\$170.00 per dose
Twinrix (Hepatitis A & B)	Adult	\$60.00 per dose
