

## March 2014 Food Inspection Results Macoupin County Public Health Department

During the month of March 2014 Macoupin County Public Health Department has inspected a variety of food service establishments. Food establishments are inspected on an annual schedule based on risk category set forth by the Illinois Food Service Sanitation Code. The risk categories are determined by the complexity of food preparation at each facility. Routine Inspections are conducted unannounced. The Food Service Sanitation Code has divided violations into two categories critical and non-critical. The categories are predetermined by the Food Service Sanitation Code. The department is publishing both types of violations.

Critical violations pose immediate health risk. These risks include product temperatures, cross contamination and personal hygiene. Critical violations are required to be corrected the same day or by a time set by the department. Non-critical violations have a less immediate risk for illness. These violations concern the cleanliness and maintenance of the facility. These are to be corrected prior to the next routine inspection.
