ROSC Definition

A Recovery Oriented System of Care (ROSC) is a coordinated network of community-based services and supports that is person-centered and builds on the strengths and resilience of individuals, families, and communities to experience recovery and improved health, wellness, and quality of life for those with or at risk of substance use and/or co-occurring mental health challenges.

The central goal of a ROSC is to create an infrastructure or system of care with the resources to effectively address the full range of substance use and mental health issues within communities.

The underlying premise of the ROSC is to promote recovery, defined by SAMHSA as *“a process of change through which individuals improve their health and wellness, live a self-directed life, and strive to reach their full potential.”*

Mission Statement

The Macoupin and Montgomery County Recovery Oriented System of Care (ROSC) is committed to reducing stigma, increasing community engagement, and improving awareness of substance use and mental health through education and outreach. We strive to foster collaboration across sectors, perspectives, and lived experiences while expanding access to diverse recovery support options and timely care. Our mission is to increase the number of individuals pursuing and sustaining recovery and to repair, renew, and restore cultural, social, economic, and family systems that have been systematically and generationally impacted.
