

MCPT Title VI Protection Public Notice

Macoupin County Public Transportation hereby gives public notice of its policy to uphold and assure full compliance with the Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, and the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987, and all related statutes. Title VI and related statutes prohibiting discrimination in Federally-assisted programs require that no person in the United States of America shall on the grounds of race, color, or national origin, sex, age, religion, family status, or disability be excluded from the participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to, discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance.

Any person who believes they have been aggrieved by an unlawful discretionary practice regarding MCPT's programs has the right to file a formal complaint. Any such complaint must be in writing and submitted to the MCPT Title VI Coordinator within one hundred eighty, (180) days following the date of the alleged occurrence.
