According to the Macoupin County Private Sewage Disposal Ordinance, all Private Sewage Disposal System Contractors operating within the boundaries of Macoupin County shall be required to obtain a Registration Certificate from the Macoupin County Public Health Department. A State (IDPH) License is required. **Please attach a copy of your valid IDPH license. If a copy is not attached, a certificate will not be issued.** This Department shall issue a certificate to persons applying for such a certificate who meet the minimum performance standards, as set forth in the Ordinance, and who pay the required annual registration fee. Please include a copy of your IDPH Private Sewage Contractors License.
